TEST: CERTIFIED INSTALLER OF ONSITE WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEMS (CIOWTS CREDENTIAL)

- + **Test Application:** The completed application must be submitted prior to December 1, 2025. The test application is in addition to the session and test registration form (found in this newsletter and available online). The test application can be downloaded at www.iowwa.com/pages/certification

or email penny@iowwa.com. Step 3 on the application, "Work Experience Verification," is required for the advanced test only.) There is no on-site submission of the CIOWTS test application.

- + **NOTE:** If less than one (1) year of onsite wastewater installation experience, completion of the Installation Overview course is required before testing.
- + **Confirmation:** A confirmation will be sent via email approximately one (1) week prior to the test date. The counties in Iowa that require the CIOWTS credential use the Basic Level. If you report to the test location after the exam start time, admission to the exam is not guaranteed and all examination fees will be forfeited. If a no-show, no refund is given for the test fee.
- + **Friday, December 12:** Test check-in at 1:00 PM / instructions at 1:15 PM / Test will start at 1:30 PM – Basic (2-hour time limit)
- + **Supplies:** Be sure to bring a small hand-held calculator and two #2 pencils to the test.
- + **Test Fee:** Basic Level Member: \$184.00, Non-member: \$209.00*

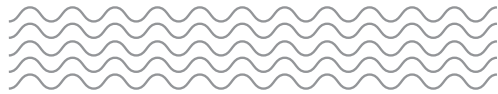
