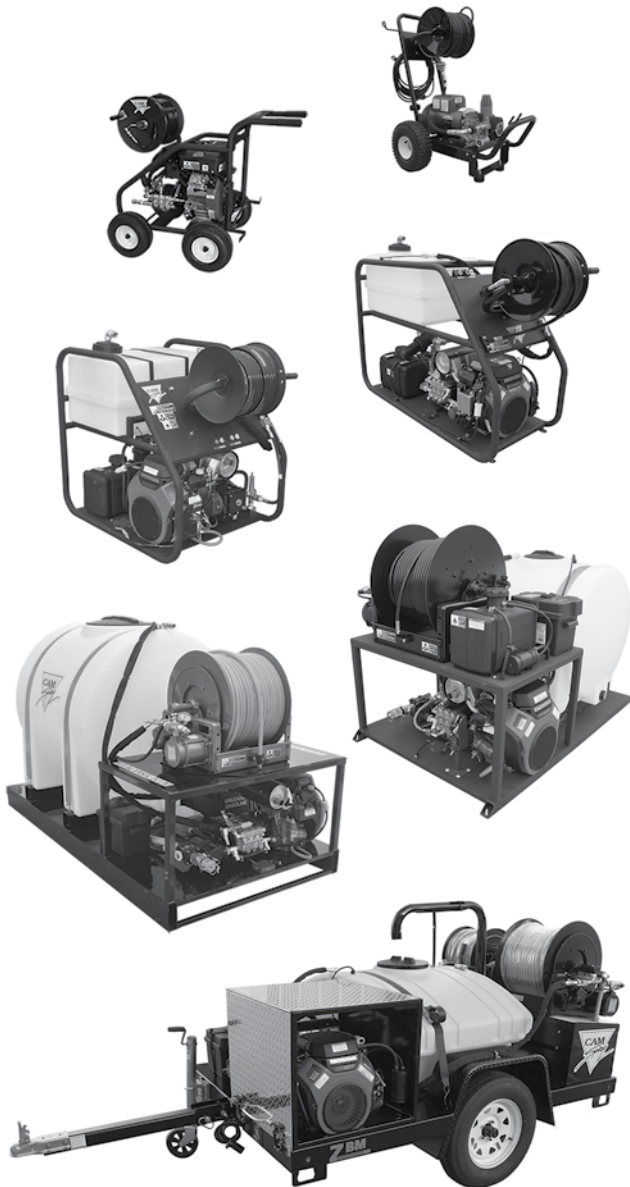

2026 *Roe-D-Hoe* WINNERS!

IOWWA's 15th Roe-D-Hoe competition at the annual conference had the top winner in the money for the first time and two other past money-recipient finishing closely behind him.



First place winner **Jason Harthorn, Harthorn Underground in Reasnor**, won with a time of 1 minute, 36 seconds.

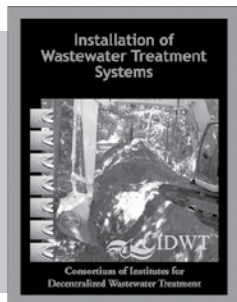

TEST: CERTIFIED INSTALLER OF ONSITE WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEMS (CLOWTS CREDENTIAL)

- + **Test Application:** The completed application must be submitted prior to March 17, 2006.
- + **NOTE:** If less than one (1) year of onsite wastewater installation experience, completion of the Installation Overview course is required before testing.
- + **A confirmation will be sent via email** approximately one (1) week prior to the test date. The counties in Iowa that require the CLOWTS credential use the Basic Level. If you report to the test location after the exam start time, admission to the exam is not guaranteed and all examination fees will be forfeited. If a no-show, no refund is given for the test fee.
- + **Thursday, March 26:** Test check-in at 1:00 PM / instructions at 1:15 PM / Test will start at 1:30 PM – Basic (2-hour time limit)

- + **Test Application:** The completed application must be submitted prior to December 1, 2025.
- + **The CLOWTS test application can be downloaded** at www.iowwa.com/pages/certification or email penny@iowwa.com. (Step 3 on application, "Work Experience Verification," is required for the advanced test only.) There is no on-site submission of the CLOWTS test application. A confirmation will be sent via email approximately one week prior to the test date.
- + **The register for the test is separate.** Register online at www.iowwa.com/pages/trainings, download the registration form or use the form in this newsletter.
- + **Be sure to bring a small hand-held calculator and two #2 pencils** to the test.
- + **Test Fee:** BASIC LEVEL Member: \$184.00 | Non-member: \$209.00*
- + **Cancellation:** A refund will be given if written notice is received at least 7 days prior to the event. A \$50 processing fee will be assessed. No refunds for cancellations received after the 7-day period.

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SCHOLARSHIP DEADLINE APPROACHES

April 15 is the deadline for applying for a \$500 IOWWA scholarship for the 2026-2027 school year. In 2025, 11 scholarships were presented thanks to companies donating funds for full scholarships and through a portion of each person's membership dues paid to IOWWA.

The Iowa Onsite Wastewater Association annual offers \$500 scholarships to:

- 1 High school seniors wanting to attend a college or a trade school on a part-time (minimum 6 credit hours per quarter or semester) or full-time basis.
- 2 Students already attending a college or trade school on a part-time (minimum 6 credit hours per quarter or semester) or full-time basis, planning on continuing their education the following year. A course of study leading to a career in the onsite industry is not required.

You are eligible if you are a student and an IOWWA member or are related to an IOWWA member (primary or associate member) and attending or planning on attending a college or trade school. Scholarships are awarded one time only per individual. Information requested includes grades/academic status, extra-curricular activities, hobbies, interests, work experience and future goals.

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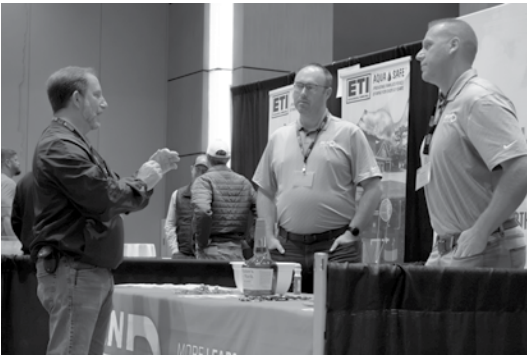
