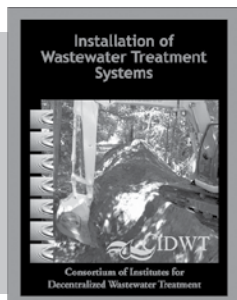
## TEST: CERTIFIED INSTALLER OF ONSITE WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEMS (CIOWTS CREDENTIAL)

- + **NOTE:** If less than one (1) year of onsite wastewater installation experience, completion of the Installation Overview course is required before testing.
- + **Test Application:** The completed application must be submitted prior to June 10, 2026.

certification or email [penny@iowwa.com](mailto:penny@iowwa.com). (Step 3 on application, "Work Experience Verification," is required for the advanced test only.) There is no on-site submission of the CIOWTS test application.

- + **A confirmation will be sent** via email approximately one (1) week prior to the test date. The counties in Iowa that require the CIOWTS credential use the Basic Level. If you report to the test location after the exam start time, admission to the exam is not guaranteed and all examination fees will be forfeited. If a no-show, no refund is given for the test fee.

- + **Friday, June 19:** Test check-in at 1:00 PM / instructions at 1:15 PM / Test will start at 1:30 PM – Basic (2-hour time limit)

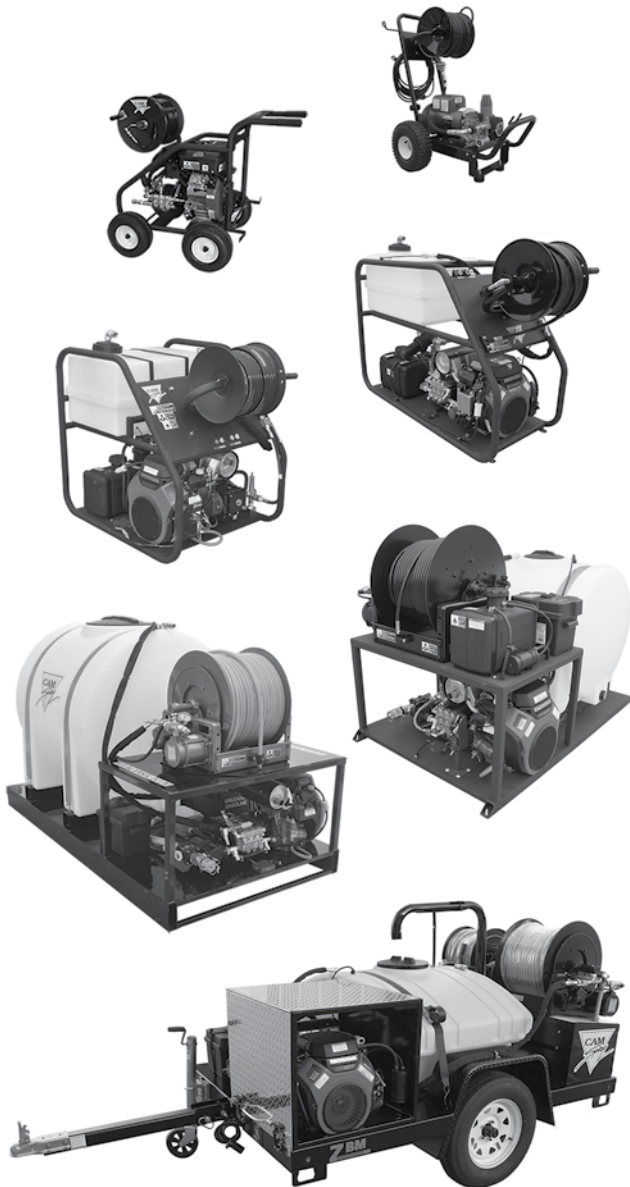

## SEPTIC PUMPING AND INSPECTION WORKSHOP

*IOWWA's May 15 workshop at Ness Pumping Services & Porta Potty Rentals in Waukon provided 6 CE hours for those attending. Instruction and insights were provided by industry speakers and participants also got outdoors for a septic pumping demonstration.*

On May 15th, the IOWWA staff and Education Committee had the opportunity to travel to northeast Iowa to host the first workshop of the season. Ness Pumping Services & Porta Potty Rentals in Waukon graciously hosted the event, bringing together industry professionals for a full day of education, networking, and hands-on learning.

The day featured a variety of knowledgeable speakers who shared valuable insight and expertise with attendees. 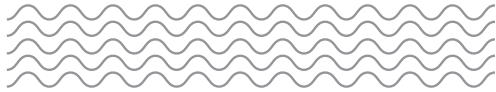
