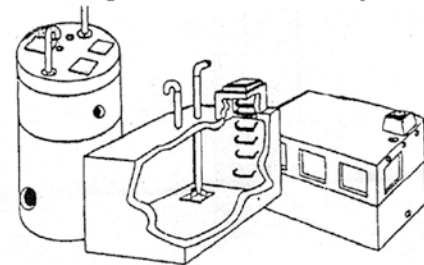

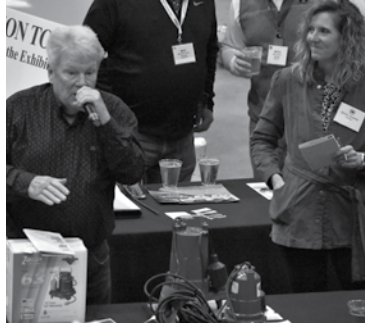
# BIG WINNERS!

# Roe-D-Hoe

## AGAIN DRAWS BACKHOE'S BEST

The competition is always tough when the state's backhoe experts take a seat and operate the controls – either Deere or CAT style – for the state's annual Roe-D-Hoe contest at IOWWA's conference. Again this year, it was a popular challenge for approximately two dozen participants who braved not-ideal weather to attend the conference and compete.



First place went to **Trevor Kirkpatrick of Vision Electric and Plumbing** with a time of 55 seconds, just off Tim Rozendaal's 52 second Iowa Roe-D-Hoe record set in 2020. Trevor took home a Roe-D-Hoe belt buckle and \$500. With an out-of-state job on his calendar for later in January, he was unable to compete nationally at the WWET show in Indianapolis. Though it was Trevor's first time participating in the IOWWA Roe-D-Hoe, he has a decade of experience on the backhoe with Deere controls and has been with Vision Electric and Plumbing for six years.



**Kyle Nekvinda, Miene Septic Service**, surprised himself — and those he works with — when he took second with a time of 1 minute 3 seconds. He chose to compete early in the contest so he could see his “name on the leader board for a short time.” He doesn't spend much time on a backhoe in his work, even though he's been able to operate one for 18 years. In 2023 — when two types of controls were first offered on the backhoe used in Iowa's Roe-D-Hoe — Kyle participated, and he went to the 2023 national WWET show with Jordan Boley of Miene, Iowa's Roe-D-Hoe champion last year, when Jordan took part in the national competition.



This is the fifth time that **Travis Hunter of Mort's Water Company**, has ended up in the money for the IOWWA Roe-D-Hoe. He finished second in 2020 and 2023, and third in 2019, 2022 and now 2024. Maybe next year will be his year!

# IOWWA'S INDUSTRY TRAINING GETS UNDERWAY

Each year after the IOWWA annual conference, the organization serves the wastewater industry with workshops in various locations. The first Installation Overview Course and test for the Certified Installer of Onsite Wastewater Treatment Systems (CIOWTS) Credential are already on the calendar for **April 2 and 3 at Ziegler CAT, 1500 Ziegler Drive in Altoona.**

## INSTALLATION OVERVIEW COURSE APRIL 2 (TUESDAY) AND 3 (WEDNESDAY)

The course is a review of the testing material and helpful in preparing for the CIOWTS test. The continuing education hours will apply to your first 2-year CIOWTS credential cycle. A total of 12 CE hours are approved for Time of Transfer continuing education.

- + **April 3:** Continental breakfast 7:30 AM

- + **Fee:** IOWWA member - \$284.00, Non-member - \$409.00\*

## CIOWTS CREDENTIALING EXAM APRIL 3 (WEDNESDAY)

**The completed application must be submitted prior to March 20, 2024.** A confirmation will be sent via email approximately one (1) week prior to the test date. The counties in Iowa that require the CIOWTS credential use the Basic Level. If you report to the test location after the exam start time, admission to the exam is not guaranteed and all examination fees will be forfeited. **If a no-show, no refund is given for the test fee.**

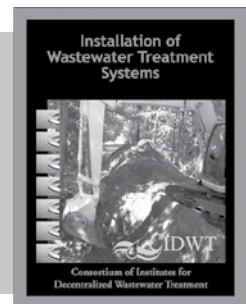
- + **April 3:** Test check-in from 12:30 – 1:00 PM; instructions at 1:00 PM; Test starts at 1:15 PM – Basic (2-hour time limit). Please be sure to bring a small hand-held calculator and two #2 pencils.
- + **Fee:** BASIC LEVEL Member - \$184.00 / Non-member: \$209.00\*

*NOTE: If less than one (1) year of onsite wastewater installation experience, completion of the Installation Overview Course is required.*

## NOTES FOR COMPLETING THE CIOWTS TEST APPLICATION:

- + Your CIOWTS test application **MUST** be submitted to IOWWA before **March 20, 2024.** NOTE: If you have less than one year experience, completion of the Installation Overview Course is required before testing.
- + The CIOWTS Test Application can be downloaded at [www.iowwa.com/pages/certification](http://www.iowwa.com/pages/certification)
- + "Work Experience Verification" is required for the **Advanced test only.**

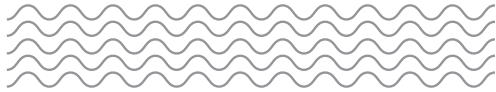
