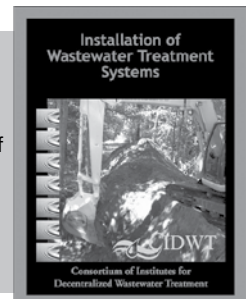

(Step 3 on application, "Work Experience Verification," is required for the Advanced test only.) There is no on-site submission of the CIOWTS test application. A confirmation will be sent via email approximately one (1) week prior to the test date.
- + **Register for the test online at www.iowwa.com/pages/trainings** or download the Registration Form.
- + **Wednesday, March 26:** Test check-in at 1:00 PM / instructions at 1:15 PM / Test will start at 1:30 PM – Basic (2-hour time limit)
- + **Test Fee:** BASIC LEVEL Member: \$184.00 | Non-member: \$209.00*

NOTES REGARDING TESTING AND APPLICATION:

- + Please be sure to bring a small hand-held calculator and two #2 pencils.
- + If less than one (1) year of onsite wastewater installation experience, completion of the Installation Overview Course is required before testing.
- + The counties in Iowa that require the CIOWTS credential use the Basic Level.
- + If you report to the test location after the exam start time, admission to the exam is not guaranteed and all examination fees will be forfeited. If a no-show, no refund is given for the test fee.

2025 Roe-D-Hoe RESULTS

Even though the competition has taken place for 14 years at IOWWA conferences, the Roe-D-Hoe still draws a crowd as the state's backhoe experts take a seat and take hold of the controls to do both the bowling and golf setups.



First place – and \$500 – went to **Jordan Boley of Miene Septic Service, Inc. of Robins**, with a time of 56 seconds (46 seconds on bowling, 10 seconds on golf), just 4 seconds off the IOWWA record set by Tim Rozendall in 2020.

Jordan earned top honors in 2023, the first time he entered the competition with a time of 1 minute 3 seconds.

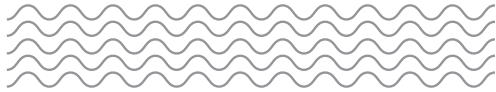
